

**SUBJECT: RoHS III Consolidated Text 2024 update 27.0 of 05/21/2024 Implementation of Delegated Directive (EU) 2024/1416 that updates exemption 39 of the RoHS II Directive. Amendment of Annex III of the RoHS Directive, in reference to exemption relating to cadmium and cadmium selenide.**

Delegated Directive 2015/863/EU (RoHS III), which updates Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS II), provides that the substances listed and reported below are not contained in electrical and electronic equipment in Annex II “Substances with use restrictions pursuant to art.4, paragraph 1, and the maximum tolerated concentrations by weight in homogeneous materials 1”:

This legislation gives specific indications on limits of use of the following substances in electrical and electronic equipment and their components:

SUBSTANCE	LIMIT	SUBSTANCE	LIMIT
Lead (Pb)	– 0,1% MCVs	Polybrominated biphenyl (PBB)	– 0,1% MCVs
Mercury (Hg)	– 0,1% MCVs	Polybrominated biphenyl ethers (PBDE)	– 0,1% MCVs
Cadmium (Cd)	– 0,01% MCVs	Bis (2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)	– 0,1% MCVs
Chromium VI (Cr VI)	– 0,1% MCVs	Benzylbutyl phthalate(BBP)	– 0,1% MCVs
Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	– 0,1% MCVs	Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	– 0,1% MCVs

The maximum concentration values allowed are 0.1% (1000 ppm). For cadmium, the limit permitted is 0.01% (100ppm) by weight for homogeneous material.

In accordance with the above, hereby TRANCERIE EMILIANE S.p.A. declares that its products comply with the limits established by Annex II of the RoHS Directive regarding the restrictions for the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS).
